Notice is hereby given that the governing Body of the City of Gregory, Texas will hold a EMERGENY CALLED Meeting in the 3rd day of November, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Gregory City Hall located at 310 Ayers St., Gregory, Texas. Pursuant to Texas government Code Section 551.127, a member of the City Council intends to participate in this meeting by videoconference call. A quorum of the City Council and the Councilmember presiding over the meeting shall be present at the location stated above, and said location shall be open to the public during all open portions of the meeting. An audio recording will be made of this meeting, and be available to the public.

The public will be permitted to offer public comments as provided by the agenda and as permitted by the presiding officer during the meeting. Should there be more than five (5) persons to speak on a particular issue, they need to select one (1) representative to speak. Your presentation will be limited to three (3) minutes. An audio recording of meeting will be made and will be available to the public in accordance with the Texas Public Information Act upon written request.

Please be advised that the open meetings act prohibits the city council from responding and discussing your comments at length. The law only authorizes them to do the following:

- Make a statement of factual information.
- Recite an existing policy in response to the inquiry.
- Advise the citizen that this subject will be placed on an agenda at a later date.

No council member, staff person, or members of the audience shall berate, embarrass, accuse, or show any personal disrespect for any member of the staff, council members, or the public at any council meeting. This policy is not meant to restrain a citizen's first amendment rights.

# ORDER DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS DUE TO WILDFIRES October 29, 2025

WHEREAS, the County of San Patricio on the 29<sup>TH</sup> of October 2025, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from imminent threat from wildfires and,

WHEREAS the County Judge of San Patricio County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for San Patricio County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Court Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the County emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 29<sup>th</sup> of October 2025.
