### CITY OF GREGORY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON ANNEXATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Gregory will conduct a public hearing on Monday, October 19, 2020, and Monday, November 2, 2020 during the regular meeting of the City Council which begins at 6:30 p.m., in the City Council Chambers of the Gregory City Hall located at 206 W. Fourth Street, Gregory, Texas. The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the annexation of the following property:

30.46 acres of land out of the northwest portion of Section "O", George H. Paul Subdivision, of the Coleman Fulton Pasture Company's Lands, generally located on the east side of FM 2986 just south of the intersection with US 181.

The petition for annexation has been submitted by the owner, Solis Enterprises, Inc. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 43.0673 of the Texas Local Government Code.

In accordance with the order of the office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, the City Council will conduct its meeting and public hearing by video conference in order to advance the public health goal of limited face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The Zoom meeting information will be available in the meeting Agenda posted at City Hall and on the City's website.

The public will be permitted to offer public comments by video conference as permitted by the presiding officer during the meeting. Written comments or questions may be submitted to the City Secretary by regular mail or by email to [norma.garcia@gregorytx.com](mailto:norma.garcia@gregorytx.com) up to five minutes after the commencement of the public hearing. Any written comments received will be included in the record of the public hearing.

Persons with disabilities desiring to participate in this meeting who may require special services are requested to contact the City Secretary at least 48 hours in advance of the public hearing.
