**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **thirty-two (32) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalization count is zero. The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 1114**. The **County's active case count moves down to 211 as this count also denotes that sixty-nine (69) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. **DSHS is reporting thirty-three (33) COVID-19 fatalities for San Patricio County at the time of this release**. The County's completed tests count is 2996. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.

**Reminder:** Isolation is required after being diagnosed with COVID-19 in order to slow the spread of this virus. The CDC recommends isolation be maintained for at least 10 days after illness onset AND at least 3 days (72 hours) after recovery. Illness onset is the date symptoms began and recovery is the resolution of fever with improvement of other symptoms.
