San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Department reported thirteen (13) new cases today that are all under investigation and our hospitalizations count remains at one (1). The County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 352. The County's active case count moves down to 144 as this count also denotes that thirty (30) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol. The County's completed tests count is 1687. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
