Public Health Preparedness Department reported twenty-one (21) new cases today that are all under investigation and our hospitalizations count stays at two (2). The County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 385. The County's active case count moves up to 156 as this count also denotes that twelve (12) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol. The County's completed tests count is 1774. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
