San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Department reported twenty-eight (28) new cases today that are all under investigation and our hospitalization count is zero. The County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 694. The County's active case count moves up to 350 as this count also denotes that twenty-six (26) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol. The County's completed tests count is 2275. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
