**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **ten (10) new cases today**. The Transmission breakdown is indicated below. **The County's active case count moves up to twenty (21)** as one (1) individual was released from COVID-19 protocol bringing our Recovered total to 37. **The County's confirmed COVID-19 case count is now 58** and our completed tests count is 746. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
