San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported six (6) new cases today and all are under investigation. However, the County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move up only to 101 as one case previously assigned to our County was done in error. The County's active case count moves down to forty-four (44) as the County released 8 individuals from COVID-19 protocol. The County's completed tests count is 859. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is low.
