San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **six (6) new cases today** and all are under investigation. However, the **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move up only to 101 as one case previously assigned to our County was done in error.** The County's active case count moves down to **forty-four (44)** as the County released **8 individuals from COVID-19 protocol.** The County's completed tests count is 859. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is low.
