San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported three (3) new cases today, announced that six (6) individuals were released from the COVID-19 protocol, and that the County had no current hospitalizations. The County's active case count moves down to eight (8). These new cases are under investigation. The County's COVID-19 total case count is 44 and our completed tests count is 732. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
