## San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Today Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported four (4) new cases that are all under investigation bringing the County's COVID-19 total case count to 22. Our completed tests count jumped to 244. One individual with an active COVID-19 case required hospitalization.

The County has received tests results from the Sinton, Mathis, and Ingleside mobile collection test sites. Results for *every* County resident who tested at one of those three (3) sites came back negative for <u>COVID-19</u>. The results for Aransas Pass and Portland are still pending. The immediate risk of transmission in the County remains minimal.
